Report of Development Director Lion Chris - Page 1 and 2 shows where I've been. Visited 97 clubs in Louisiana. At the direction of the board, spoke with prospective doctors about becoming outlying clinics. Glaucoma program over. Goal for the Glaucoma screening was 30. Final numbers were 51 screenings with 1,483 persons screened. Lions are making a difference in peoples lives. Screening van already booked for Louisiana next year.
